- ❖ Entries are limited to a maximum of 4 Technical tests, 1 Freestyle, and 2 Let's Get Rockin' Classes.
- ❖ Horses are limited to 4 classes per day (includes Let's Get Rockin' Classes).
- ❖ You may ride in no more than 2 consecutive Levels (e.g.; Training Test 4 and First Level Test 1 **OR** Fourth Level Test 3 and FEI PSG).
- ❖ Each test may only be ridden once. If you wish to ride a test twice, the second test will be hors concour, and will only be scheduled if time permits.
- ❖ Order of go is randomized.
- ❖ All tests will be ridden in the 20 X 60 meter ring.
- ❖ The Gate will be open for all tests – all rings (except where specified).
